WHEREAS, on December 2, 1011 at approximately 12:25 p.m., Officer Josh Brum was on routine patrol when he observed a woman standing on the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks near Davis Street. The woman was standing with her arms outstretched as a train was rapidly approaching on the tracks and it was evident the woman was attempting suicide; and

WHEREAS, without regard for his personal safety, Officer Brum quickly removed the woman from the railroad tracks and brought her to a location of safety just before the train would have struck her; and

WHEREAS, thanks to his quick and selfless action, Officer Brum saved this woman's life while at the same time averted a possible disaster for the train operator and the passengers; and

WHEREAS, Officer Brum's actions demonstrate the bravery and integrity that exemplify the San Leandro Police Department, and his dedication to duty and this community bring honor to the entire San Leandro Police Department.
