WHEREAS, on November 11, 2011 at approximately 9:30 a.m., Officer Jonathan Remulla, while on routine patrol duty, was dispatched to a home on Warbler Court on report of a two-year old child who was non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, upon Officer Remulla's arrival at the home, he found the young boy in the arms of his grandmother. The boy was unconscious and did not respond to Officer Remulla's physical and verbal attempts to arouse him; and

WHEREAS, thanks to his training and experience as a Police Officer, Officer Remulla knew to place the child on a stable surface to examine him. He quickly saw what appeared to be food in the back of the child's throat, inserted his finger in the child's mouth and cleared his airway of the obstruction, whereupon the child began breathing; and


WHEREAS, without Officer Remulla's quick response and rapid intervention, the child may not have survived; and
