

# Proclamation

Issued By The Mayor

WHEREAS, bicycling is a healthy, non-polluting, low-cost, energy-efficient mode of travel; and

WHEREAS, to encourage bicycling in San Leandro, the City has updated its Bicycle Master Plan. This Plan provides a blueprint for making bicycling an integral part of daily life in San Leandro and will help guide future development of bicycle facilities and programs; and

WHEREAS, the Bicycle Master Plan has a Vision Statement that provides "*A city where walking and bicycling are fully integrated into daily life, providing environmentally-friendly transportation alternatives that are both safe and convenient for people of all ages and abilities;*" and


WHEREAS, during the entire month of May bicycle transportation will be celebrated and encouraged in the Bay Area through many entertaining events, fun rides, bike safety classes, and numerous energizer station on the morning of Bike to Work Day, May 10, including an energizer station at the San Leandro BART Station; and

WHEREAS, San Leandro encourages all of its residents to consider bicycling on May 10 to help promote Bike to Work Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Stephen H. Cassidy, Mayor of the City of San Leandro, on behalf of the City Council, do hereby proclaim May 10, 2012 as "**BIKE TO WORK DAY**" in the City of San Leandro in recognition of this City's commitment to making San Leandro a more bike-able city. We encourage everyone to consider bicycling, to sign up for a free bicycle safety class, and urge motorists to slow down and watch for bicyclists.
