Food Scrap Recycling Program - Compost Giveaway Event

**Friday, June 8 (7:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.) and Saturday, June 9 (9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.), Public Works Service Center, 14200 Chapman Road**

- The City of San Leandro will host a compost giveaway event on **June 8 and June 9**. Residents may redeem their coupons received with their garbage bill for two bags of free compost. The compost is available on a first-come-first-serve basis while supplies last.
- The compost giveaway program rewards residents that participate in the food scrap recycling program offered through Alameda County Industries (ACI) and Waste Management of Alameda County. Since 2003, the City has distributed over 60,000 bags of compost, processed from our residents' yard trimmings and food scraps. Using compost in gardens and landscapes is beneficial in many ways including reducing the need for water, fertilizers, and pesticides.
