Council Information

Pacific Gas & Electric Company's (PG&E) Crossbore Inspection Project

- In 2008, PG&E upgraded the gas facilities in various areas around San Leandro. PG&E replaced the existing gas pipelines with modern piping that is more resistant to corrosion and earthquakes. However, it has been noted within PG&E's distribution areas that there have been a few instances of "crossbores," which are defined as gas lines penetrating through private sewer laterals causing a potentially hazardous situation. In an effort to avoid such hazards, PG&E is working with Frontline Energy Services and Pipeline Video Inspection & Cleaning, L.L.C. to video inspect the laterals by gaining access through the City of San Leandro sewer mainlines. In the rare instance that a crossbore is found on a property, PG&E will respond to the site to make all necessary repairs. Attached is a [PG&E presentation](#) describing the work in further detail.
- A letter is being sent by PG&E to all property owners, business owners and residents within the work limits. A [list of streets](#) and [map](#) of streets that will be inspected is also attached. One week prior to the start of work, all residents and business owners will receive a door hanger explaining the project and what to expect during construction. A Frontline Energy Services representative will also be on site during construction should customers have any concerns.
