## Council Information

### Recycling Program Update

- The Recycling Program continues to conduct outreach on two upcoming ordinances that will affect San Leandro residents and businesses: the Polystyrene Foam Food Service Ware Ordinance, effective November 1, 2012 and the Single Use Bag Reduction Ordinance, effective countywide on January 1, 2013. In the last few months, the Recycling Program and StopWaste.org have conducted the following activities:
  - Distributed outreach at the Farmers Market – 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month (May – October)
  - Placed reusable bag information in Recreation Guide (Summer Edition)
  - StopWaste.org sent two letters to retailers regarding bag ordinance
  - StopWaste.org developed fact sheet, website and phone line for bag ordinance ([www.ReusableBagsAC.org](http://www.ReusableBagsAC.org))
  - Distributed information regarding both ordinances at the City's Annual Compost giveaway in June
  - Sent information to the San Leandro Chamber of Commerce to distribute to members
  - Emailed approximately 500 subscribers on Recycling Program list about the ordinances
  - Placed advertisements regarding the Polystyrene Foam Food Service Ware ban in the *San Leandro Times* on July 5 and July 26

- Placed information about the ordinances as calendar and news items on City website
- Updated the Recycling Program website ([www.recyclesanleandro.org](http://www.recyclesanleandro.org)) with ordinance information
- Promoted reusable bags through Bay Area campaign ([www.igotmybag.org](http://www.igotmybag.org))
- Placed polystyrene information in Fall/Winter Recreation Activity Guide (page 11)
- We will continue to place advertisements in the *San Leandro Times* and conduct other low and no-cost outreach as scheduled in the Recycling Program Outreach Plan over the next few months in advance of the two ordinances.

### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION**

This report is for information only, and no action is required.

### **BACKGROUND**

Each summer, since 1963, the San Leandro City Junior Golf Championship has been played at Monarch Bay (formerly the San Leandro Golf Complex). Originally, this event had 30 to 40 participants, ages 7 to 17, from San Leandro and surrounding communities competing in this one-day event.

### **DISCUSSION**

This year, the San Leandro City Junior Golf Championship was held on both courses at Monarch Bay on August 9. Over 180 juniors participated this year, again making the San Leandro City Junior Championship one of the largest junior golf tournaments in Northern California. The overall boy's champion this year was Jimmy Castles from Cupertino with a score of 68 and the overall girl's champion was Elizabeth Schultz from Lafayette with a score of 74.

The continued success of the tournament is due largely to the more than 40 volunteers from American Golf and the San Leandro Golf Club at Monarch Bay. The Public Works Department has managed this event since 1996. Under Public Works administration, this tournament has grown from 55 participants in 1995 to well over 300 participants in 2007. Due to the difficult economic times as well as competing junior golf events, participation at all junior golf tournaments are down from the peak year in 2007. However, even with the drop in participation this year, San Leandro City Junior Golf Championship remains one of the largest junior golf tournaments in Northern California. Also each year, the San Leandro City Junior Golf Championship generates more golf course revenues from participants, parents and spectators than any other weekday in the month of August.

### **CONCLUSION**

The San Leandro City Junior Golf Championship has grown to be one of the largest single-day City Junior Golf Championships in California. The Public Works Department and American Golf continue to grow the game of golf by hosting various junior golf competitions at Monarch Bay.

Other junior events held at Monarch Bay include the High School Girls Spring Invitational and the High School Boys Fall Invitational. Over 400 juniors participate in golf events managed by the Public Works Department on an annual basis.
