## CITY APPOINTS TWO NEW DEPARTMENT HEADS

City Manager Chris Zapata announced recently the promotion of staff members to lead the Community Development and Public Works departments.

**Cynthia Battenberg**, who has worked on the billion-dollar Kaiser Medical Center project and the ultrafast fiber optic project, Lit San Leandro, has been appointed Community Development Director.

Battenberg will head the Community Development Department, which facilitates business development, housing services, planning services and building and safety services.

**Debbie Pollart** has been selected to lead the Public Works Department after stints in planning and managing San Leandro's Marina and Shoreline areas.

As the Public Works Director, Pollart will oversee a budget of \$23 million, which includes the Water Pollution Control Plant that processes 5 million gallons of wastewater each day, 50 city facilities, 180 miles of streets, 200 vehicles/pieces of equipment, 315 acres of restored marsh habitat, 17 parks and 3 pools.

Their selections follow the hiring of David Baum to head the Finance Department, LaTanya Bellow in Human Resources, Theresa Mallon as Library Director and Deborah Acosta as the East Bay's and San Leandro's first Chief Innovation Officer.

## CITY COUNCIL APPOINTS RICHARD PIO RODA SL CITY ATTORNEY

Effective April 8, Mayor Stephen Cassidy announced that the San Leandro City Council voted unanimously to appoint Assistant City Attorney **Richard D. Pio Roda** to be City Attorney. He takes over this position from Jayne Williams, who has served as San Leandro's City Attorney for nine years and will continue to provide legal services to the City as an assistant to the City Attorney.

Pio Roda has served as San Leandro's Assistant City Attorney for the past five years and was counsel to the City's Board of Zoning Adjustments and Planning Commission.

Pio Roda is a Principal with the law firm of Meyers Nave and practices in the areas of municipal and special district law, public contracts and construction, land use, real estate, and education law. He also routinely advises on risk and litigation management. From 2004 to 2007, he served as the Assistant City Attorney for the cities of Milpitas and Oakley.

Pio Roda is frequently requested as a trainer and speaker on government ethics, conflicts of interest, public contracting, construction and public procurement.



## SLPD STAFF HONORED FOR NATIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATIONS WEEK

From April 14 through April 20, 2013, we celebrate National Public Safety Telecommunications week, honoring Public Safety Dispatchers around the country, for the role they play in public safety.

Each year, the second full week of April is dedicated to the women and men who serve as public safety telecommunicators. It is designated as a time when citizens can thank public safety women and men who respond to emergency calls and dispatch emergency personnel during times of crisis. A banquet in honor of the 9-1-1 call takers and dispatchers, communications trainers and technicians that maintain radio and 9-1-1 telephone equipment, will be held on April 20.

Many people take for granted the service provided by dispatchers who are the true “first responders” to a citizen’s call for help. These professionals are not only the calm voice to citizens, but also to the officers faced with life and death decisions on the street. They are often behind the scenes in an emergency incident. In 2012, San Leandro’s dispatchers were responsible for answering more than 89,000 calls for service from the public.

This year, we recognize Megan Wilske, as our Dispatcher of the Year. Megan has been with the San Leandro Police Department since August of 1999 and this is the second time she has received this accolade. She is a calm presence in the dispatch center, always smiling and always willing to help. This is exemplified in her leadership role as the Explorer Advisor. “Her professionalism and dedication to her job is an example for everyone to follow”, stated Sergeant Mike Sobek.

“Dispatchers are the first point of contact between the police and the community. It is a position which involves complex multi-tasking, management and leadership. We are celebrating and recognizing our dispatchers during National Public Safety Telecommunications for the work they do 24 hours a day / 7 days a week. Their work is critical to the success of our mission,” said San Leandro Police Chief Sandra Spagnoli.
