

Proclamation

Issued By The Mayor

WHEREAS, in 1962 Congress and the President of the United States designated May 15th as Peace Officers Memorial Day, and the week in which it falls as National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, the dedicated members of the San Leandro Police Department have chosen law enforcement as a career, play an essential role in preserving the freedom, rights and safety of citizens, maintaining a core set of values of Teamwork, Integrity, Professionalism and Service; and

WHEREAS, it is important that the community understands the duties, responsibilities, hazards and sacrifices of law enforcement agencies, and that the members of our law enforcement agency recognize their duty to serve the people by safeguarding life and property, by protecting against violence and disorder, and by protecting the innocent against deception and the weak against oppression; and

WHEREAS, National Police Week honors police officers who have dedicated their lives to the service of humanity through public safety and those officers who have given their lives in this noble cause should be recognized for their brave and valiant service. Tragically, three San Leandro Police Officers were killed in the line of duty.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Stephen H. Cassidy, Mayor of the City of San Leandro, on behalf of the City Council, do hereby proclaim May 12-18, 2013, as “**NATIONAL POLICE WEEK**” in the City of San Leandro and urge all citizens to join the Police Department in honoring our three fallen officers: Fred R. Haller, Donald F. Spingola, and Nels Daniel Niemi, who through their courageous deeds, made the ultimate sacrifice in service to our community, by visiting the Public Safety Memorial located in front of the San Leandro Police Department.
