Potable Water Discharge in San Leandro Creek

- On June 19, a resident notified Public Works that there was unusually high flow in upper San Leandro Creek.
- Environmental Services investigated the issue and determined that the flow was coming from the City of Oakland.
- East Bay MUD was contacted and determined that the source was an overflowing water tank near the golf course.
- The problem had been fixed by the time the source was identified but an unknown amount of potable water had been released into the creek creating muddy water.

- Environmental Services reported the discharge to California Office of Emergency Services (OES) as a precaution.

Council Follow-Up

Neighborhood Cleanup Program Update

- On Saturday, June 1, over 350 residents hosted garage sales at their homes and approximately 300 residents recycled items that would have otherwise been landfilled. The recycling event was held at Alameda County Industries where 4 tons of electronic waste, 3 tons of scrap metal, 4 tons of wood, and 48 appliances were successfully captured. In addition, 89 mattresses, 1,480 pounds of batteries, and 617 pounds of fluorescent bulbs and lamps were recycled.
- The Neighborhood Cleanup Program offers residents opportunities to reuse and recycle unwanted goods, reduces incidents of stockpiling in residential yards and garages, increases community involvement, and provides education to residents on managing bulky waste. The program is an integral component of the City of San Leandro's efforts toward exceeding State mandates for solid waste diversion.
