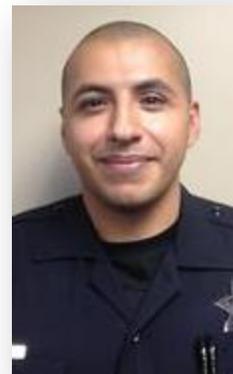

### Two New Officers Join San Leandro Police Department

- Please join me in welcoming two new additions to the SLPD:
  - **Officer Justin Blankinship** comes to the SLPD after working as a special agent with the State of CA Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control for the past year. Prior to working as a special agent, Justin served as an Oakland Police Officer assigned to a specialized unit working undercover operations in local bars. Justin was an instructor of the Oakland Police Department's Firearms and Defensive Tactics program. He is a proud member of the Police Unity Tour, a bicycle tour that raises awareness of law enforcement officers who have died in the line of duty, and has completed the ride from New Jersey to Washington, D.C. for the past four years. After graduating high school, he continued his education and attended Solano Community College. Justin started his in-house training on July 29, 2013 and will begin the Field Training Program on August 9, 2013.
  - **Officer Anthony Pantoja** has joined the San Leandro Police Department after working as a Los Angeles Police Officer for the past year and a half. Anthony attended Chabot College, where he received his Associate of Arts Degree in Liberal Arts, before transferring to San Francisco State University, where he earned his Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice. Throughout college, Anthony worked as a loss prevention officer for Macy's, and spent three years working at the Bayfair Center store. His friends and co-workers describe Anthony as someone with a patient demeanor, excellent communication skills, a strong work ethic, and who builds trust with everyone he encounters. We welcomed Anthony to the San Leandro Police Department on July 29, 2013 and will also begin the Field Training Program on August 9, 2013.

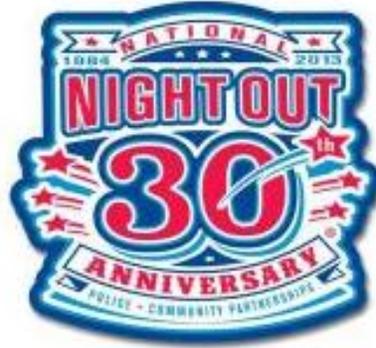

## *America's Night Out Against Crime*

### *August 6, 2013*

Join members of your community, the San Leandro Police Department, and the Alameda County Fire Department in the 30th Annual National Night Out (NNO), sponsored by the National Association of Town Watch. Last year's National Night Out campaign involved citizens, law enforcement agencies, civic groups, businesses, neighborhood organizations and local officials from over 15,000 communities. In all, it is estimated that in 2012 over 37 million people participated in "America's Night Out Against Crime." NNO is designed to: Heighten crime and drug prevention awareness; Generate support for, and participation in, Neighborhood Watch Programs and other anti-crime efforts; Strengthen neighborhood spirit and Police/Community relations; and Send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are fighting back against crime.

The National Association of Town Watch was established in 1981 as a nonprofit, crime prevention organization. The first National Night Out was introduced in 1984. San Leandro has a long history of participating in National Night Out. For more than 20 years members of the Police Department have been visiting neighborhood activities throughout the City. In 2012, 32 neighborhood events took place. We would like to encourage members of the community to participate in the 2013 National Night Out.
