### Notification of Night Work at San Leandro Station

Dear Community Member:

As part of our systemwide Earthquake Safety Program, BART is in the process of strengthening structures at the San Leandro Station to withstand future earthquakes. For safety reasons some of the work will need to take place at night when the station is not open. The schedule for this work is as follows:

**Tuesday, November 19, 2013 through Thursday, November 21, 2013**  
**12 am – 5 am**

BART will monitor noise and dust and will work to minimize any inconvenience to the surrounding community. Additionally, the contractor has carefully planned the work to direct lights downward and shield equipment. We appreciate your patience and cooperation and will work to minimize inconveniences during this construction.
