This has been an exciting month with the opening of Kaiser Permanente, work on the 350-foot mural at Preferred Freezer and the completion of improvements to the 840-unit Lakeside Apartment complex. We are also completing the San Leandro Boulevard improvements for a safer, nicer core next to the San Leandro BART station. More improvements are on the way with the Westlake/OSisoft Technology Complex and the 200-unit Cornerstone housing development.







September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014, new businesses that are located in the City of San Leandro will pay no business license tax until 2015 and the zoning approval fee will be waived!

Please note: Although the fee is waived, it is still necessary for all businesses to obtain a business license.
