Recycling Program Receives Commendation for Medication Take Back Program

- The City's Recycling Program was recognized at the Alameda County MEDS Coalition Safe Drug Disposal Rally, held at Eden Medical Center on August 18th. Staff was presented with a certificate of commendation for providing the community a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs.
- Residents may bring unwanted or expired medications to one of the following locations:

- San Leandro residents may place medicines, including prescription drugs, over-the-counter medications, liquid medicines, medicated ointments and lotions, and medications for pets in secured pharmaceutical waste bins that are available at each site. Pills should be transferred into a zip lock bag prior to dropping off at the site.
- Hours of operation vary according to the location. Please contact each location for medication drop-off hours.

Standard & Poor's Raises City of San Leandro Credit Rating

Standard & Poor's has raised its issuer credit rating for the City of San Leandro to 'AA-' from 'A+' in its latest review, published on August 15th. The rating applies to the City's lease revenue bonds, certificates of participation, and pension obligation bonds. The upgrade has the potential to save the City hundreds of thousands of dollars in future borrowing costs, and is based on San Leandro's strong economy, strong budget flexibility, liquidity, and strong management, according to Standard & Poor's.
