Community Assistance Grant Program

- The Community Assistance Grant Program (CAP) provides financial support to non-profit organizations providing social services and programs for individuals and families living in San Leandro. City staff released a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the two-year funding cycle (2015-17) and received 14 proposals from local agencies.
- In February, the Human Services Commission and staff will review and evaluate each application and conduct a site visit if necessary to assess program

eligibility. Applicants will be required to make a short presentation before the Commission on February 7th. The Commission will discuss recommendations at their February 18 meeting and will subsequently bring forward their final recommendations to the City Council for approval as a component of the HUD action plan.
