Sing Tao Daily and Radio Presented with Certificate of Appreciation (photos attached)

- On August 3rd, San Leandro Police Detective Abe Teng presented a certificate of appreciation from the San Leandro Police Department and Council Member Benny Lee to Sing Tao Daily and Radio for their partnership and support on Community Outreach to the greater Bay Area Chinese Community. As part of SLPD's on-going community outreach efforts, Detective Abe Teng has participated on Sing Tao Chinese Radio, discussing crime prevention and providing safety tips to listeners.

Current San Leandro Crime Statistics (flyers attached)

- Attached are the latest crime statistics for June, 2015. Overall Part 1 crime for 2015 is down four percent, in addition to theft and burglary crimes. Auto theft continues to be an issue not only in Alameda County but across the state. Violent crime has increased slightly, which is seen as part of a regional issue. Cities continue to feel the impact of Public Safety Realignment (AB109) and also Proposition 47, which has reduced penalties for certain classes of crimes, and has a direct correlation to crime in Alameda County.

Crime Prevention

- As a result of incidents at movie theaters and active shooters across the country, SLPD has reached out to Century 16 regarding safety and crime prevention. SLPD has an agreement with Century for a paid (reimbursed) assignment on Friday and Saturday nights at the theater.

Crime Intel Meetings

- City Council members have an open invitation to attend the Crime Intel Meeting. Although the meetings do not necessarily focus on specific Council Districts, they provide a high level overview on the crime issues in San Leandro as well as policing strategies SLPD is using to address quality of life issues and crime. SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

AC Transit has invited the public to an Open House for the Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) on August 6, 2015 from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the BRT Community Information Center located at 3322A International Boulevard in Oakland.

This report is for information only and no action is required.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

AC Transit is in the process of completing the bid documents for the main BRT project, which constructs an enhanced bus service between 20th Avenue/Broadway in Oakland and the San Leandro Downtown BART Station. AC Transit plans to start construction on this phase of the project in late Spring 2015. Currently, AC Transit is completing the utility relocation phase of the project. Most of the utility relocation work in San Leandro has been completed (except for waterline relocation in front of the City Hall).

The Open House is intended to provide updates to the public on the project. Project and Construction Updates, Parking and Landscape Improvements and the Business Sustainability Program are some of the topics that will be addressed that evening.
