## Council Information

### Public Works Turf to Mulch Demonstration

As part of Saturday’s Earth Day event at Root Park, Public Works staff partnered with UC Berkeley’s Stephan Andrews to demonstrate how to replace turf with mulch. This pilot project will assist staff in determining how the process works and identify sites that are a good fit for EBMUD’s \$20,000 grant to convert public parks, medians and buildings to mulch. The demonstration will cover approximately 1,000 square feet and attendees will be able to assist in the demonstration.

### Chief's Advisory Board Update

The Police Department Chief's Advisory Board was established in April 2013 under the direction of the Chief of Police. The board was created to act as a community resource for the Chief in the formation of strategies, development of community policing concepts and increasing public awareness. 
