COMPACT FLUORESCENT LIGHTS COLLECTION

ON-CALL BULKY ITEM PICKUP

You call, we'll haul. Call Waste Management Customer Service at (510) 613-8710 to schedule free individual pick-ups twice per year, at your convenience.



FOOD SCRAP RECYCLING

All food products, including meat & bones and food soiled paper, such as pizza boxes, paper towels, paper plates, paper napkins & waxed paper containers should be placed into your green waste cart for weekly curbside collection. Do not put any liquid, plastic, glass, metal or Styrofoam products into your green waste cart. For questions about Food Scrap Recycling, call Waste Management (510) 613-8710.



FREE HOLIDAY TREE-CYCLING PICKUP

Trees are picked up curbside during the first two weeks of January on your regular pickup day.

Trees must be cut to less than 5 feet tall. Only clean trees will be picked up: no "snow" flocking, stands or decorations. Flocked trees must be discarded as trash.



FREE BATTERY COLLECTION

Household batteries (AAA, AA, B, C, D & small button batteries), including rechargeable and cell phone batteries, can be recycled. Place batteries in a clear plastic bag, seal shut & place on the top of the recycling cart.



FREE CELL PHONE COLLECTION

Residential customers may now recycle cellular phones. Place old cell phones in a clear plastic bag, seal shut and place on top of the recycling cart.



USED MOTOR OIL & FILTER COLLECTION

Call Waste Management at (510) 613-8710 to request free used motor oil jugs and filter bags. Set out up to 2 jugs and 2 filters curbside for pick up on your regular collection day.

Only WM oil jugs & bags will be accepted for pickup.

Magazines, Newspapers, Office Paper, Cardboard, Junk Mail, Cup Lids, Stickies, Aluminum Cans, Pans & Foil, All Metal Cans, Empty Aerosol Cans, Plastic Bags & Films (bagged together in a clear plastic bag), Glass & Plastic Bottles, Plastic Containers, Plastic To-Go Boxes, Rigid Plastics no larger than 15" in any dimension

INFORMATION

ORO LOMA SANITARY DISTRICT RESIDENTIAL TRASH SERVICES
Your trash is typically collected weekly in 20, 35, 64 or 96 gallon wheeled burgundy carts. Customers can change the size of their container by calling Waste Management at (510) 613-8710.

SCHEDULE & SET-OUT INFORMATION

- Wheel carts to street curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day. Residential collection will be provided Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Do not overload carts; lids must close. Overage fees may apply to overflowing carts.
- Place dry-cell household batteries in a sealed heavy duty plastic bag on top of your gray or brown recycling cart.
- Place cell phones in a sealed heavy duty plastic bag on top of your gray or brown recycling cart.
- For occasional extras, 32 gallon Bag-its for garbage may be purchased from Waste Management by calling (510) 613-8710 or by calling Oro Loma Sanitary District at (510) 276-4700.
- The standard cart size for recycling (gray or brown cart) and green waste (green cart) is a 64 gallon cart. Residents may increase cart size up to a 96 gallon cart at no additional charge. Contact Waste Management at (510) 613-8710 to increase your recycling or green waste cart size. Customers may also request additional recycling carts and up to two (2) green waste carts at no additional charge.
- Holidays are Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. When a holiday falls on a weekday, pickup will be one day later for the rest of that week.
