













Crime Suppression Team



- Formed to provide the Department with the ability to quickly address emerging crime trends and problem areas identified through Crime Analysis.
- Allows the Department to direct resources to a specific problem
- Philosophy- crime can be deterred through:
 - Proactive enforcement
 - Directed enforcement
 - Creative problem oriented policing strategies



Crime Suppression Team Stats



- 5 walking stops
- 42 traffic stops
- 78 Field Investigations
- 4 probation searches (not including probation/parole sweep)
- 5 firearms recovered
- 47 arrests






Community Outreach
