


San Leandro Trails and Bikeways Map



Bike Safety Tips



Always Ride with Traffic

State law requires bicyclists to ride on the same side of the road as other vehicles.



Observe Traffic Rules

Bicycles must be driven like other vehicles and obey all traffic rules, including stop signs.



Use Hand Signals

By law, you must signal your intent to turn to other vehicles and fellow cyclists.



Keep Clear of the Door Zone

It is unsafe to ride too close to parked cars. Keep a distance of at least 4 feet between yourself and parked cars.



Use Lights at Night

Headlights must be visible from 500 feet, and a rear reflector or light from 300 feet. Wheel and pedal reflectors are also required.




Follow Lane Markings

Like a vehicle, you cannot go straight from a right turn lane.



Choose Best Way to Turn Left

You can turn left as a vehicle, from the left lane, or as a pedestrian, in the crosswalk. If you use a crosswalk, dismount and walk your bike across.



Avoid Road Hazards

Be especially aware of railroad tracks and drainage grates. Cross railroad tracks perpendicularly and avoid parallel-slat drainage grates.

Tips for Biking In San Leandro:

- Bicycle riding should always be done defensively. Scan the road for vehicles and anticipate their movements. Motorists may not always see you.
- City code prohibits riding bicycles on sidewalks unless you are under 12 years of age.
- Dress appropriately – wear bright clothing and dress in layers to adjust to temperature changes.
- Keep your bike well-maintained, properly adjusted, and outfitted with reflectors and lights. Always wear a helmet.
