ADDENDUM NO. 2

April 10, 2003

TO: All Prospective Bidders

The additions and/or deletions contained in this Addendum shall be made a part of the plans and specifications and contract documents for the above described project, and shall be subject to all applicable requirements thereunder, as if originally shown and/or specified.

THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS SHALL BE REVISED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Enclosed "Revised Contract Price Schedule" supersedes "Contract Price Schedule" included in the bid documents. Contractor must submit the "Revised Contract Price Schedule" (**pink copy**) as a part of the proposal, in lieu of "Contract Price Schedule" to the City.
2. **Section 300-2.1.1, Roadway Excavation/Grinding and Offhaul - MEASUREMENT** has been revised to read, "The estimated quantity for unclassified excavation for Bid Item No. 6, "Roadway Excavation & Offhaul", shall be the FINAL QUANTITY for which payment for excavation will be made, unless the dimensions of excavation shown on the plans are revised by the Engineer. 4-inch cold milling (grinding) on Callan Ave. shall be paid per Bid Item No. 22, "Cold Mill & Offhaul 4" AC", Bid Item No. 7, "Cold Mill & Offhaul 2 1/2" AC", Bid Item No. 8, "1 1/4"x5' Keycut", Bid Item No. 9, "2 1/2"x15' Keycut (Merced)" and Bid Item No. 10, "2 1/2"x25' Conforms", shall be paid per field measurement. If such dimensions are revised and such revisions result in an increase or decrease in the quantities of such work, the final quantities for payment will be revised in the amount represented by the changes in the dimensions. The estimated quantities for excavation shall be considered as approximate only and no guarantee is made that these quantities which are determined by computations, based on the details and dimensions shown on the plans, will equal the actual quantities excavated. No allowance will be made in the event that the quantities based on computations do not equal the actual quantities excavated."
3. **Section 300-2.1.2 PAYMENT BID ITEM NOS. 6, 7, 8, 9 AND 10** has been revised to read, "The contract unit price paid for Bid Item No. 6, Roadway Excavation & Offhaul, Bid Item No. 7, "Cold Mill & Offhaul 2 1/2" AC", Bid Item No. 8, "1 1/4"x5' Keycut", Bid Item No. 9, "2 1/2"x15' Keycut", Bid Item No. 10, "2 1/2"x25' Conforms" and Bid Item No. 22, "Cold Mill & Offhaul 4" AC", shall include full compensation for

furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all work involved in removing AC gutter overlays; AC and/or concrete gutter rumps; slurry seal; including excavation, various cold milling (grinding) and keycut items, sloping, rounding, tops and ends of excavations, including installing, removing and disposing of transitions, loading hauling, and disposing of surplus materials, stockpiling, and hauling to its final location as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, and as directed by the engineer.

4. Delete quantity tables listed on plan sheets 2, 7 and 12.
5. **Section 3-2.1.1 Changes Initiated by the City** The following items are added to the list items the City can make changes greater than 25% without adjust in the contract unit prices:
 - a) Adjust Manhole Frame & Cover to Grade
 - b) Furnish, Install and Adjust Frame & Cover to Grade
6. **Section 301-1.6 Adjustment of Manhole Frame and Cover Sets to Grade - MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT – BID ITEM NO. 3** has been revised to read, ‘The Contract price paid per each for Adjust Manhole Frame and Cover to Grade, **Bid Item No. 3**, Adjust Fiber Optic Manhole Frame and Cover to Grade, **Bid Item No. 32**, and Furnish, Install and Adjust Manhole Frame and Cover to Grade, **Bid Item No. 33**, shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all work involved in referencing; removing; protecting survey points; salvaging; stockpiling; cleaning; furnishing concrete and asphalt concrete; replacing sanitary sewer manholes protective coating; installing and adjusting to grade as shown on the plans, as specified in the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer
