Any bid may be withdrawn at any time prior to the time fixed for the opening of bids only by written request for the withdrawal of the bid filed with the City. The request shall be executed by the bidder or bidder's duly authorized representative. The withdrawal of a bid does not prejudice the right of the bidder to file a new bid. Whether or not bids are opened exactly at the time fixed in the public notice for opening bids, a bid will not be received after that time nor may any bid be withdrawn after the time fixed in the public notice for opening of bids.

As stated in Public Contract Code Section 5100 to 5108, inclusive (State Contract Act) concerning relief of bidders and in particular to the requirement therein, that if the bidder claims a mistake was made in his bid, the bidder shall give the City written notice within five (5) days after the opening of the bids of the alleged mistake, specifying in the notice, in detail how the mistake occurred.

All bidders shall verify if any addendum for this project has been issued by the City. It is the bidder's responsibility to ensure that all requirements of contract addendum are included in the bidder's submittal.

The successful bidder shall submit a certificate of insurance showing compliance with the enclosed insurance requirements. This insurance shall be maintained at all times during the course of any resulting agreement. In addition, the successful bidder shall have the proper City of San Leandro business license and all other applicable licenses and permits.

The award will be made to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid complies with the specifications in a manner satisfactory to the City's best interests as determined by the City. The right is reserved, as the interest of the City may require, to reject any or all bids, or to waive any informality or minor irregularity in the bids.

Payment shall be within 30 days following acceptance of bid items.

ONE (1) CURRENT MODEL STUMP CUTTER

SPECIFICATIONS:

The following specifications are minimum unless otherwise specified.

Engine:

- A. Air cooled, supercharged diesel
- B. 80 horsepower @ 2800 RPM
- C. Engine to be equipped with a full-flow, spin on replaceable oil filter

Dimensions:

- A. Length to be 167 inches maximum
- B. Width to be 80 inches maximum
- C. Overall height to be 79 inches maximum
- D. Weight to be 3960 pounds maximum

Chassis:

- A. To be constructed of reinforced 4 inch tubing
- B. The boom construction to be of 5 inch square tubing
- C. Axle to be a torsion axle rated at 6000 pounds

Fuel Tank:

25 gallon capacity

Hydraulic System:

- A. Hydraulic pump to be driven directly from engine
- B. System to be open center with a return type 6 micron, 100 mesh suction strainer type
- C. Maximum relief pressure shall be 200 P.S.I.
- D. Hydraulic tank capacity, 3 gallons

Electrical:

- A. 12Volt system
- B. 950 C.C.A. maintenance free battery, secured in a battery compartment

Cutting Wheel:

- A. Diameter, twenty – eight (28) inches without teeth
- B. Number of cutting teeth, forty-two (42) (carbide tipped)
- C. Tooth and pocket assemblies shall be of two piece construction of forged steel, secured to the cutting wheel with 2 bolts
- D. Cutting dimensions must be a minimum of twenty-five (25) inches below ground, thirty-five (35) inches above ground, with an arc of one hundred three (103) inches
- E. The unit shall be able to telescope via a hydraulic tongue cylinder, sixty (60) inches
- F. The unit shall be equipped with a mechanism that detects R.P.M. drop at the engine and automatically slows the cutting sweep rate until the engine R.P.M. recovers to full R.P.M.

Instrumentation/Controls:

- A. Unit to have an hour meter, a warning light for low oil pressure, and high water temperature
- B. Automatic low oil pressure shutdown and high water temperature shutdown switches
- C. The unit shall have separate controls for swing (left/right), forward/backward movement and up/down movement. These controls to be mounted on a swing out control arm
- D. The throttle and ignition switch shall be mounted on control arm
- E. Control arm shall have an operator shield, constructed of polycarbonate 3/16 inches thick

Instrumentation/Controls (continued):

- F. The unit must be equipped with electric brakes that incorporate a safety breakaway switch
- G. The unit must be equipped to be towed and have 2 safety chains, 2 stop- turn tail lights
- H. Unit to have a 2-inch adjustable ball hitch

Tires and Wheels:

- A. To be equal to 8.75 -16.5 LT, tubeless, load capacity
- B. Wheels to be 16.5 x 6.75

Drive:

- A. The cutting wheel system must be a direct, gearbox type drive
- B. Drive to consist of an upper gearbox, attached to rubber dampened driveshaft with U-joints and a lower gear box

Miscellaneous:

- A. Standard manufactures warranty
- B. One (1) each set of operator, parts and maintenance manuals
- C. Operator/technician training to be provided by successful bidder
- D. D.M.V registration to be completed by successful bidder
- E. Unit to be painted yellow
- F. Swivel type tongue jack
- G. One (1) spare wheel and tire assembly

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
