

SHORELINE DEVELOPMENT CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPOINTMENTS OPEN

Mayor Stephen H. Cassidy has announced that three openings exist for appointment to the San Leandro Shoreline Development Citizens Advisory Committee (Shoreline CAC). The Shoreline CAC provides input to the City Council and development team on a comprehensive master plan for approximately 40 acres of San Leandro's shoreline. The goal of the new shoreline development is to provide additional amenities to the San Leandro community that recognize and connect with current uses at the shoreline, such as the Monarch Bay Golf Course. The long-term vision for the plan is that its implementation must require little or no City investment and result in a Shoreline that is self-sustaining.

“The input the City Council has received from the Citizens Advisory Committee has been valuable as we work together with a developer to plan the future of the marina area within the San Leandro shoreline, said Mayor Stephen H. Cassidy. “I have the opportunity to add three more San Leandro residents to the committee and am interested in hearing from anyone who would wish to serve.”

Applications for appointment to the CAC must be received by the City's Office of Business Development by the end of the business day on Wednesday, March 9, 2011.
