**City Council Meetings Audio Streaming on Web Beginning with
Mayor's 2011 State of the City Address**

City Council Work Session to Discuss Shoreline Marina Harbor Basin Study

Beginning Monday evening, March 21, San Leandro City Council meetings will be heard through streaming audio on the City of San Leandro website, in time for Mayor Stephen Cassidy's 2011 State of the City Address.

"Live audio streaming of City Council meetings is another milestone on the path to using technology to enhance the transparency, accessibility, and ultimately accountability of City Hall," said Mayor Stephen Cassidy. "Community members unable to attend a City Council meeting in person will now be able to listen in while the meeting is occurring, hear the important dialogue that occurs among the City Council, City staff and community members present, and know what has been decided as the decisions are made."

Prior to the City Council meeting, a City Council Work Session will be held, also in the City Council Chambers, for a presentation on the results of a Harbor Basin study undertaken to examine options for the future of the San Leandro marina harbor. A Shoreline Development Citizens Advisory Committee has been working with City staff and master developer Cal-Coast on concepts which would bring community amenities to the harbor area.
