Are you and your family experiencing a housing crisis?

- Are you behind on your rent and has your landlord given you notice to pay or quit?
- Are you about to be evicted from subsidized housing or public housing?
- Are you staying with friends or relatives and been told you have to leave?
- Are you staying in a shelter, on the streets, or a place not meant for people to live (i.e. a car, an abandoned building, a shed, the street)?
- Are you staying in a hotel until your money runs out?

You may be eligible for homeless prevention or rapid re-housing financial assistance and services through the Mid-County Housing Resource Center or another Priority Home Partnership Program.
